Measles alert!

There have been cases of measles (English measles) recently notified in the Wellington region. As yet, we have not been notified of any cases amongst our Crèche children.

If we do have a case however, anyone, including babies children, teachers and other adults, who is not up to date with their vaccinations will need to stay away from the Crèche for at least 14 days. This may need to be extended if there are further cases of measles at the Crèche.

To be protected against measles, children need to have had two doses of the MMR vaccine (Measles, mumps rubella); usually given at 15 months and 4 years. The measles vaccine is free from your family doctor.
